1 What is Prayer ?

Change

If you would ask me to give you one word to describe Prayer- it would be this –
'CHANGE'

Change you may ask, what has change to do with Prayer. After all is prayer not asking, seeking and knocking? True as that may be yet none of this can be truth unless God can first have His way with our hearts. For God to have His way with our hearts there must be change. To ask of God, to seek of Him, and to knock on the door of Heaven is only worth your while if you are willing to have a change of heart. Going to God has never been about the blessing of one's own

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desires unless those desires have come from the Lord in the first place. The key is to receive from Him that which He so desires. Has this not so stalled the consistency of many a prayer life. The desire to please God springs from the salvation of the spirit. Our souls are often in opposition to the work of the Holy Spirit.

Psalm 37.4-5 'Delight yourself in the Lord and He will give you the desires of your heart.'

vs 5 says 'Commit your way to the Lord; trust also in Him; and He shall bring it to pass.' NIV

The original Hebrew meaning of the word delight is to be 'soft and pliable 'in the hands of God.'

Prayer is responsible for causing this softness, Prayer, yes Prayer is responsible for the creation of this pliability before God.

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It is a removing of what we want and replacing it with what He desires. That word **'it'** in **verse 5** is the desires that He now places in our hearts that we can pray back to Him. To **'Commit'** according to this scripture is to surrender or to give over to Him all the deciding. Difficult as it may seem, yet it is so nevertheless.

It is here at this place in our journey with the Lord, that He is able place in our hearts the desires we allowed Him to. I hope that you will understand this very important principle of Prayer.

Any wonder why you are never the same after going to God.

'For my thoughts are not your thoughts, neither are your ways my ways, declares the Lord. As the heavens are higher than the earth, so are my ways higher than your

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ways, and my thoughts than your thoughts.’ Isaiah 55.8-9 NIV

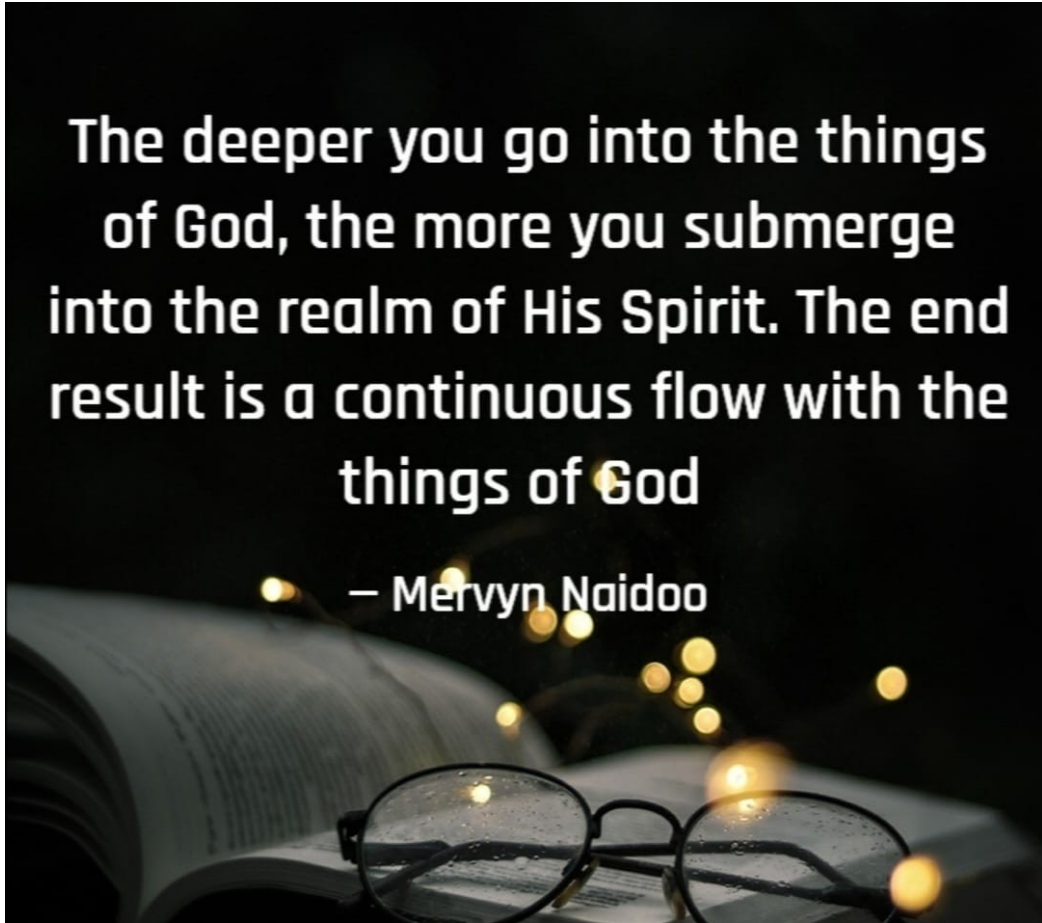
This then my friend is a Life Hidden in Prayer. Welcome it, embrace it and be a part of what God is doing.

2 The Revelation of who God is

You know no amount of writing or talking about prayer can ever complete the life of prayer. Books and much about prayer may be seen and heard but they are there merely to assist us in one of the most powerful duties of the Christ life. And yet even though there is a hidden life in prayer it is a life that is bursting to be revealed. The longer and more consistently we are willing to approach the throne of God, the deeper we are moved to understanding God. Prayer reveals the heart of God. The apostle Paul understood this fully well. In his letter

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to the church in Ephesus he wrote the following ‘.....and I pray that you, being rooted and established in love, may have the power, together with all the saints, to grasp how wide and long and high and deep is the love of Christ, and to know this love that surpasses knowledge- that you may be filled to the measure of all the fullness of God. Ephesians 3.17-19 Paul knew that the key to this understanding was prayer.’

Prayer is what God has already established for this revelation, and many other duties of the church life will not reveal this. There has since never been a substitute for prayer.

And the aspects and characteristics of prayer are the most intimate and fundamental of who God is.

Prayer reveals who God is and by knowing who He is we are then able to know the

provisions that have already been set aside for us. Note what I just said the key is to first know who God is. The revelation of who God is is the revelation of His nature and character. The more we are introduced to God the more closely we become associated with Him .It is this association with Him that causes us children to become more familiar with His ways. The more time we spend with Him, on a personal level, the more we come to know who He is. In us coming to know who God is we come to know ourselves.

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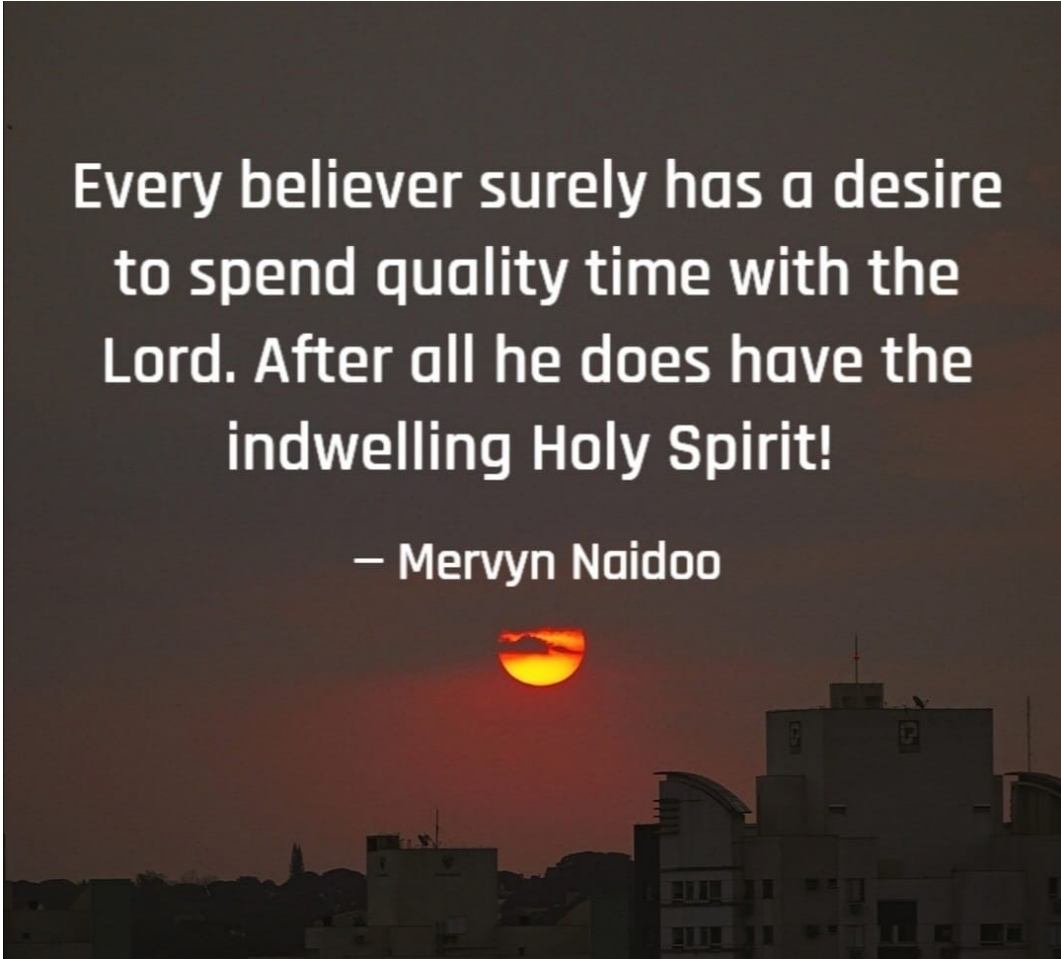

3 God and His Desires

I am often asked why I should pray, after all God knows all things. Him being the all omnipotent God, He surely knows my needs. To speak thus is to reveal our misunderstanding of who God really is and the true nature and character of God. God does know all things, true. He knows your needs and your desires. But do you know His heart. To put God first is to know the very heart of God. The desires that you now have are never as important as the desires and plans that God has for you. True prayer is come to God, and surrender your plans and your desires to Him. Prayer is the key to appropriating the resources that are available to us in Christ, yet more important prayer, true prayer reveals to God by the

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virtue of choice given to us, that we are dependable on Him.

Prayer my friend, in actual fact, was never meant to change the heart of God but to change ours. I will say that again Prayer was never meant to change the heart of God but to change ours. All that God desires and has for us is the best and He will not settle that we have anything to the contrary. But this dependability on God reveals your heart and gives God the opportunity to change yours. That's what prayer does. It takes away the desires of your heart and replaces it with His desires. The psalmist understood this well. Let's read Psalm 27.4 'one thing have I desired of the Lord, that will I seek: That I may dwell in the house of the Lord all the days of my life, to behold the beauty of the Lord and to enquire in His temple.' Now I like that word enquire. It is to seek after

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and find out. Prayer is the key to developing this intimate relationship with God.

The more one spends time in His presence the more you will hunger for what He has. The prayer life is the revelation of a Father's heart to be with His children and to give them life to the full. John 10.10 confirms this "The thief comes only to steal and kill and destroy; I have come that they may have life; and have it the full."

To pray and to know how to pray is the key to knowing the nature of God. Much is revealed through the life of prayer, that most duties, of the church life, never will reveal or ever come close. This then is the life hidden in prayer.

4 Prayer Reveals who God is!

There are significant essentials that any believer must know when it comes to the life of prayer. They are the essentials to keep one focused. For there are many prayers by many a people that are really not the fragrance intended for Gods' presence.

The prayer of a Godly heart reaches the God of heaven.

The desire to know God is the first step on the road of one acquainting one self to Him. Paul's prayer to the church in Ephesus echoed this..... '.....and I pray that you, being rooted and established in love, may have the power ,together with all the saints, to grasp how wide and long and high and

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deep is the love of Christ, and to know this love that surpasses knowledge- that you may be filled to the measure of all the fullness of God. Ephesians 3.17-19

To know the desires of God for you is important. Remember that you are unique in the eyes of the Lord. Gods' purpose for you is therefore special, of which He holds the key. Psalm 139.16 - 17 '.....all the days ordained for me were written in your book before one of them came to be.' How precious to me are your thoughts, O God, how vast is the sum of them.'

To know the manner and ways I am to come before the King of kings, must never be taken for granted. It holds the key in, to you being in His presence or not. This is about a KING, His Kingdom and the Provisions set aside in this Kingdom. Any

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wonder why Jesus said 'THIS THEN IS HOW YOU SHOULD PRAY...Matt. 6.9

To pray without ceasing is a directive from the Lord regarding our prayers. We would be wise to never forget this. In Luke 18.1 we read 'Then Jesus told his disciples a parable to show them that they should always pray and not give up.' The purpose of the parable was to show them they should press on no matter what. This is to pray without ceasing.

As Gods' people it would be wise to be aware of that which is taking place in the spiritual and physical realm, after we have prayed. The reason for this is to flow with what God is busy doing, and thereafter to pray accordingly. (Repeat word) This then is to watch and pray according to Matthew

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26.41. Watching and praying will also keep you from falling into temptation. The key here is to flow with the Spirit of God.

Finally our prayers must never lack us being thankful to God. To be thankful and full of praise, is a great part of what makes up the prayer life. Praise and thanksgiving should not come only after a prayer request has been granted. In prayer we come to God in faith for the work already completed in Christ. Though that specific answer may not have manifested yet we nevertheless honour God. “ Through Jesus, therefore, let us continually offer to God a sacrifice of praise – the fruit of lips that confess his name.’ Hebrew 13.15

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My prayer for you is that you to will understand this principle of prayer. And May you be a part of this life hidden in prayer.

5 Understanding the Kingdom of God

You know our understanding of the basics of Gods' kingdom will actually help us understand why prayer is so important in the lives of us believers. Understanding how the kingdom of God operates will help us know why God has placed such significance to prayer. First of all we need to understand that God is King. One who is king will always have a kingdom to rule. That kingdom of God is the Kingdom of Heaven. Every kingdom has a set of rules that govern that kingdom. God reigns in His Kingdom and has absolute and sovereign reign over all things. The earth also belongs to God but He has given this to man to reign in. Man is

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to rule earth by the set of rules set up by God and His Kingdom. For man to know how to rule in this kingdom he must be first acquainted with the King and His set of rules. This will give man a better grip on his reign here on earth. You see Prayer is that means that God has designed or proposed for man to know what is in heaven. When man knows what is in Heaven and is familiar with the Kings' ways he can then apply them on earth. 'Your kingdom come, your will be done on earth as it is in heaven.' Matthew 6.10 . Simply put Prayer helps man to reign.

Prayer is the means that transfers that which is spiritual to the physical which is earth. God has given us the Holy Spirit to help us do so. Now here in lies the problem. If we are found lacking or sluggish in our praying there will be very little of Heaven

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here on earth.x2. The more the body faints in praying the more earth is bound to crumble. Many things have piled up in heaven based on this simple truth of people not praying. Heaven is not selfish to release what it has for earth. Remember what God has for earth is already planned and ready to be released from heaven. 'Your will be done on earth as it is already done in heaven.' The problem is that man is so absorbed in the things of the world that Heaven has to wait. God will not fill the heart of man with that which is heavenly if he (man) has not first had a change of heart. Prayer helps towards this change of heart. For it is through prayer that God removes our selfish wants and places His desires into our hearts. There must be a change of heart in the believer for Gods' will to be done here on earth.

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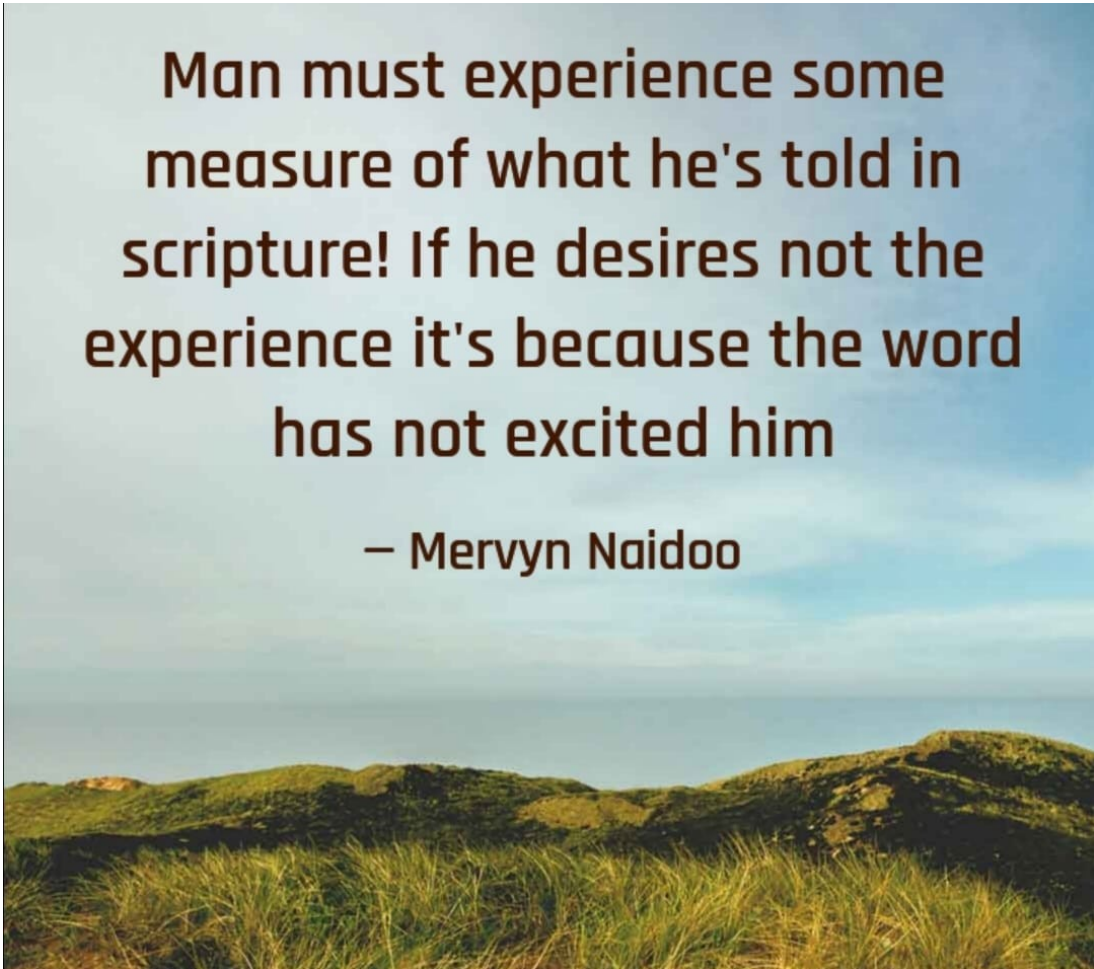
My prayer today is that you would make the decision that firm decision to hear what God has for you, to be willing to receive from Him and most of all to be willing for God to change your heart.

6 What is the Will of God?

Prayer is simply the union of the believers' thoughts with Gods' x2. Prayer is Gods' way of telling the church what He wishes to be done on earth. The duty of the believer is to pray out this accomplishment here on earth. Prayer is not meant to enlighten God. God knows all things. Prayer expresses our faith, our trust and expectations of the Lord. In other words our prayers must show forth to God that we desire what He already has purposed for us. The meaning of that word amen is not 'let it be' because I prayed it so but 'it is so' because you have already said so according to your word.

Prayer, true praying is not asking of God to do what we want, although we may think so, its' certainly not. Our praying and the strength of our praying will determine how much of what God so desires, is really being accomplished here on earth.

Matthew 6.10 says 'your kingdom come, your will be done on earth as it is in heaven' Other bible translations have it has 'as it is already done in heaven.' The fact that God has already prepared it for you also means He is not going to alter that which He already has prepared for you. What he has prepared is the best. What happens though is that much of what God has purposed for us is stalled in heaven because of our lack of praying or our wrong way of praying. Many things have piled up in heaven simply

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because man will not pray according to Gods' will.

Now let me briefly explain that word 'will' which is found in Matthew 6.10.

Will – In the original Greek has two meaning:

1 – 'Boulema'- eternal will of God. In other words it will be done whether you like it or not.

Eg. The return of Christ, the gathering of the elect, matt.24.30-31, the judgement of each person according to what he has done here on earth.Rev.20.13

2 – Thelema – This is God's desire for us and is dependant on us- the response of the believer. Do you want what God has for you? Prayer makes known to God your heart. The response to that is made very clear in Jeremiah 29.12-13 'Then you will

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call upon me and pray to me, and I will listen to you. You will seek me and find me when you seek me with all your heart.'

The key here is for God to see that your heart truly desires to have what He has for you, or that you are at least willing for Him to change your heart - The willingness for God to give you a new heart.

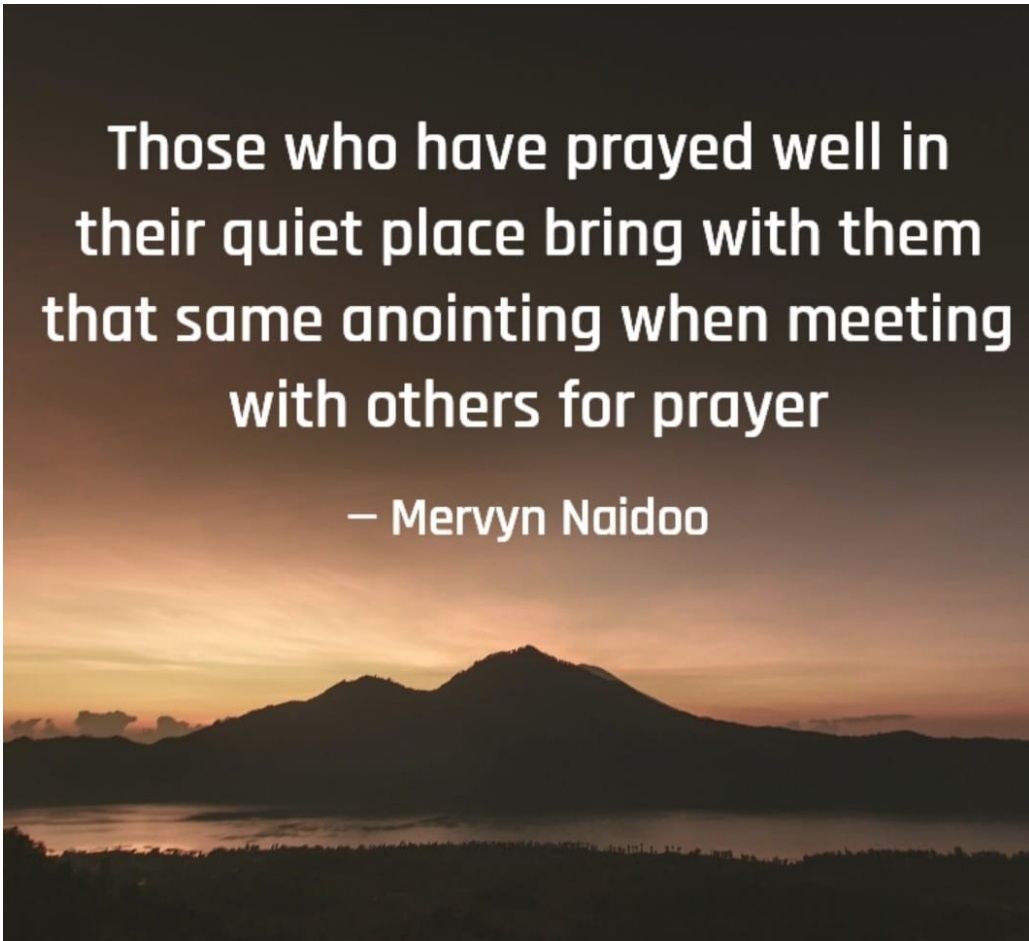
In our willingness to do it Gods' way we will be drawn into a whole new life – a life hidden in prayer.

7 Bind and Loose

I want to make something very clear regarding prayer to you today. For us to really understand how to pray and what true prayer is we will have to come to understand the true nature and character of God - Knowing who God is. Failure to do so can really place great strain on the believer. The misunderstanding of who God is can only lead to great disappointment in our lives. For when our prayers are not answered, this can be the first step to us questioning and doubting God.

One the most misquoted scriptures regarding prayer is that found in Matthew 18.18 ' I tell you the truth, whatever you bind on earth will be bound in heaven, and

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whatever you loose on earth will be loosed in heaven'

Now let me make this very clear, as we have shared before. Prayer does not alter that which God has already determined, that being the good that He already has in store for you. It may be suspended because of our selfishness and lack of cooperation with Him.

You see because earth has bound does not necessarily mean that God is obligated in heaven to bind. God binds in heaven what is bound on earth simply because it was Gods' original intent and will to bind what earth has now bound. To be able to bind in the first place one must be given the authority to bind. Jesus speaks of this in Matthew 16.19. That authority no doubt is given to us. The words 'will be bound' and 'will be loosed' means Jesus has activated this

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through His life, death and resurrection. Jesus has passed this authority to the church and the duty of the church is to leaven? the earth with His kingdom power and provision. The true basis of this praying, the one answered will be the prayer after Gods' will. The reason for this is very simple. Gods' will is Gods' wish.

Let me add this when a man wants to do what God wishes done, God will have that done at any cost, at any sacrifice. God does not answer all 'praying'. What we think is praying may actually not be praying at all. I think that is where most of our problems lie. Many of our prayers are never answered simply because God does not wish them for us. Our wishes must be a reflection of Gods'. The wish in us (if it is Gods' will) is the equivalent of the answer.

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Why? because it is already done in the mind of God.

May God grant us the ability to learn to live this great and Holy life. May we remember the solemn words of our Saviour who said: 'not everyone that saith unto me, Lord, Lord, shall enter into the kingdom of heaven, but he that doeth the will of my Father, which is in heaven'

May God open the door of your heart to understand His will here on earth and may I remind you today that God has intended Prayer, true praying to be the way your heart comes to know His.

8 BUILDING A HOUSE FOR GOD

1 How do we build a house for God ?

Isaiah 56.7 'Their burnt offerings and sacrifices will be accepted on my altar; for my house shall be called a house of prayer for all nations.'

The burnt offerings and physical sacrifices have been taken away by our Lord Jesus and have now been replaced by spiritual sacrifices. Prayer and worship is the spiritual sacrifice that now awaits heaven. The prayers of Gods' people are the incense that rises before the throne of God. The strength of that fragrance is determined by the strength of our prayers. They are the

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building blocks of the New Testament church. This is what builds the house of God. Building the house of God is to enthrone Him.

In Old Testament times we read about the importance of bringing the right sacrifice and offerings, and the regulations governing them. We read about the making of the Anointing Oils and the Incense, the making of the tabernacle, the tent and all its' furnishing materials, we read about the ark itself and all its' attachments, we know much about the priestly garments and the specific materials that had to be used. And through all of this we are taken into a world of God and His dimensions, all of this being HOLINESS UNTO THE LORD.

The question is How much more important is this spiritual house that God looks out for now. The spiritual sacrifice of today is of

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greater importance, and being as that may, how much more precise and flawless must this sacrifice be. The prayer life of the believer is what makes up this spiritual sacrifice and so the House of God is built.

What house are you building for the Lord today? Is your spiritual house in order? The prayer of each believer is the building blocks of this house. The strength of your praying will determine the blocks being used. The intimacy you have with God, the time you spend in His presence and your obedience to His voice is what gives strength to this spiritual House. This is the life of prayer. Although our Lord lives in a high and lofty place, He desires to dwell among His people. He is a God who particular about His House. And His must be built in a certain way. The house now being

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built speaks much about the heart of the believer and his intimacy with God.

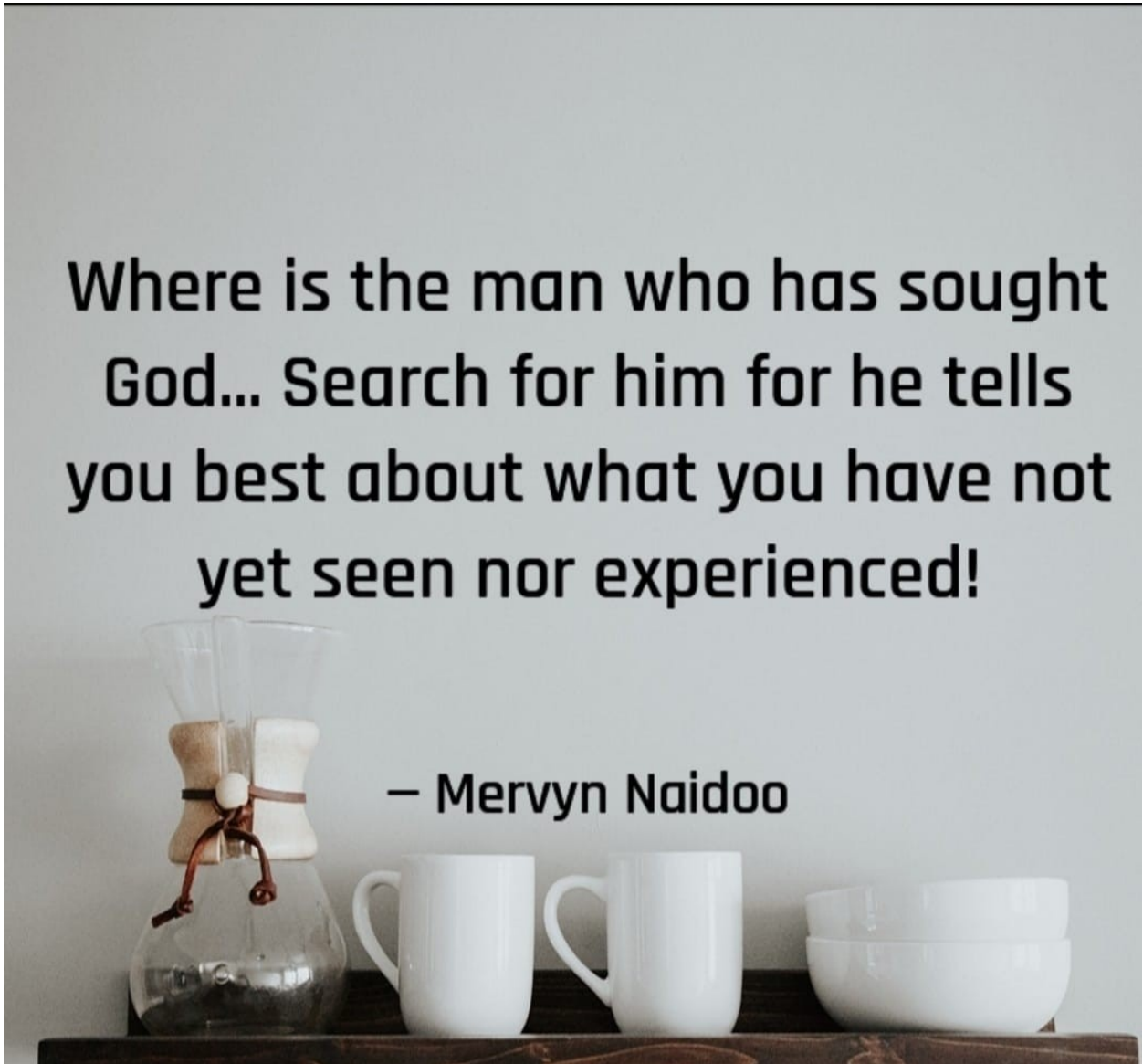

9 Protocol with God

Is it not strange how we follow protocol when it comes to so many of our earthly activities. In fact the diligence we have in following these earthly matters far too often exceeds the diligence we have concerning the things of God. Prayer is one of those aspects that we so often lack the diligence and the protocol. When I speak about diligence then I want you to be mindful of the most important commandment given to man and that is God be given first place and priority in your life. Priority is to give God main concern, it is to give God precedence over everything

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else and letting Him have His way. This we will share later on.

When it comes to protocol imagine you were to receive a call from the presidents' office to meet with the president of your country tomorrow. Apart from it being a honour, you will certainly not go to him unprepared. One of the first things you would enquire would be the dress code, you may enquire about the matter at hand, you would find out more about him as a person and you would enquire that manner of how you may approach him and the way you are to speak to him. All of this becomes very useful as it is not the same as visiting a friend down the road. You would make sure that you are well prepared. Remember that this is your president that we are speaking of, now what about God, your creator and King of the heavens and the earth. Has he

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not called you to come and meet with Him and how are you responding? I want you to think about this.

The life of prayer demands protocol with God. As New Testament priests we too have a protocol to follow. It is not the same as the worlds' but it is a protocol more important. Firstly you must know that there is no other way to the Father except through His Son Jesus Christ. John 14. 6 make this very clear. ' ... No one comes to the Father except through me.'

Living as New Testament priests means there is a protocol to follow. For this reason Jesus demonstrated to His disciples how they should pray. When the disciples came to Jesus and asked Him to teach them how they should pray, Jesus did not reply: 'follow your heart and pray whatever is in

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your heart.’ But instead His reply was ‘after this manner pray’

The manner that Jesus thought the disciples to pray is the manner we are all called to pray. Please understand that the manner of praying that Jesus spoke of is not a ritual as so many think it is but it is the way of approach to a Holy God and the direction of our hearts to His.

The ‘Lords’ prayer’ or the ‘Our Father prayer’ as we know it, has the most complete and absolute utterances that children of God may cast back to Heaven. The personal petitions contained in this prayer are very modest- daily bread, forgiveness, and deliverance from sins’ power.

Yet they are what comprise all things that pertain to life and Holiness. I pray that your eyes will be opened today to the guidelines of approach to this our heavenly Father.

10 Our Lord's Manner of Prayer

To pray as heaven would wish is to echo the very words that beat and come together with our Heavenly Father. This is to be at peace with God. If prayer was whatever we desired to utter before God then we would not have been warned by Lord. By Jesus demonstrating the manner that we ought to pray He was teaching us the correct way of approaching the throne of the Father. And where there is correct way there is bound to be a wrong way that will rise up. The manner shown by the Lord shows us that the way we are to come into the

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presence of our Father is of priority and protocol. Hear what Jesus warns us about praying foolishly.” And when you pray, do not keep on babbling like pagans, for they think that they will be heard because of their many words. For by your words you will be acquitted, and by your words you will be condemned. Do not be like them (the pagans), for your Father knows what you need before you ask Him” Matt. 6. 7-8

Therefore the “Our Father”/Lords’ Prayer as it is called is the most complete and absolute utterances children of God may cast back to heaven. To pray after the manner shown to us by the Lord gives strength to our desire to pray as it is in Gods’ will in the first place. The mind is also kept from wandering for there is much to be prayed for when we follow in the

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manner given to us. To receive from the Lord is to hear from the Lord. To hear from God is to live a life in the Spirit. 'He who belongs to God hears what God says.....'John 8.47 'In this manner, therefore pray' Matt. 6.9 was the instruction and advise given to us by the Lord.

We would be wise to obey and in so doing experience the richness hidden for God's people through the life of prayer. May you welcome the life hidden in prayer?

My call today is that you be found praying without ceasing!
